## At a Glance

The Delhi 2010 Commonwealth Games – the biggest cultural and sporting event ever held in India – officially commences on Sunday October 3 with the Opening Ceremony to be held at the internationally renowned Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium. Around 6,000 athletes from 70 Nations and Territories – representing one third of the world's population – will compete in 17 sports over 12 days of ceremonies and competition.

Press Operations is a critical area for the Organising Committee Commonwealth Games Delhi 2010. It is responsible for providing all facilities and services to accredited press, media and photographers to ensure the best possible coverage of the XIX Commonwealth Games 2010 Delhi. The Press Operations FA D2010 will co-ordinate with all other relevant Functions to ensure seamless service delivery at the Main Press Centre (MPC) and all Venue Media Centres (VMCs).

The objectives of D2010 Press Operations Functions are:

- To promote a positive image of India to the national and international community by working closely with the national and international media and ensuring their support and involvement in the Games
- To provide working facilities and essential services such as technology, hospitality, accommodation, accreditation, transportation etc., for the accredited press, photographers and non-rights holding electronic media covering D2010

The key functions of Press Operations are:

**Main Press Centre:** Creating a central work place for the accredited press (print and photographers) and non-rights holding broadcasters providing telecommunications, results and information, central services and press conference rooms

**Venue Media Centres:** Providing press work areas at competition venues or serving a cluster of venues

**Photo Service:** Providing accredited still photographers with work areas photo positions and telecommunication requirements

**Media Services:** Facilitating accreditation, accommodation, Press rate card and transport

**Games News Service:** Providing editorial content for the Games Information System (GIS) including accurate Athlete Biographies and past performance statistics, which provides real support time results as well as news, background and information on the Games

## **Main Press Centre**

### **INTRODUCTION**

The Main Press Centre (MPC) is the nerve centre base for accredited media covering the Delhi 2010 Commonwealth Games. The MPC is located in Indian Trade Promotion Organisation Complex (ITPO) which is situated in the heart of Delhi, within 10 minutes driving distance from the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium.

The MPC encompasses almost 6,700 square metres, one of the largest exhibition hall in the ITPO Complex. The ITPO Complex also hosts the International Broadcast Centre.

### **Media Transport Mall**

A dedicated media transport service operates for all accredited media from the Media Transport Mall. The Media Transport Mall is located at the west end of the venue adjacent to the Main Press Centre. The transport service connects the Main Press Centre to all competition venues, selected non-competition venues and official media hotels.

Representatives from the media transport service are located at the Transport Desk to assist media with their transport enquiries. The media transport service timetable is available from the Transport Desk or on GamesINFO.

### **Public Transport**

The ITPO Complex is also accessible by public transport. The Pragati Maidan Metro Station is a 10-minute walk, north of the venue via the Service Lane through Gate No 10. City buses, autorickshaws and cabs are available along Pragati Maidan Gate No.7, which is 10-minute walk from the MPC.

### **Media Entry**

A dedicated entry for media is located at the west end of the Indian Trade Promotion Organisation Complex (ITPO), adjacent to the Media Transport Mall, through Gate No.7.

## **FACILITIES**

### **Welcome Desk**

The Welcome Desk has information regarding all aspects of media servicing for the Delhi 2010 Commonwealth Games. Upon arrival, all journalists and photographers should check-in at the Welcome Desk. This is the collection point for Games media kits, messages, general Games information and lost and found items.

Media organisations that have ordered Private Office Space should check-in with the Rate Card Services team located at the Welcome Desk. The Rate Card Services team operates a check-in and check-out procedure to ensure all products and services are delivered as ordered.

## **Help Desk**

A Help Desk is conveniently located near the media and photo work areas for general assistance and enquiries. Keys for locker rentals are available from the Help Desk.

## **Business Centre**

The Business Centre, situated near the media and photo work areas, is equipped with photocopier and fax machines operated by the Media Services team. Photocopying is free of charge and faxing is a user-pay service, operated with pre-paid phone cards. Additionally, phone card vending machines are conveniently located throughout the MPC for purchase of phone cards.

## **Media Work Area**

The media work area for journalists is central to all services and facilities in the heart of the MPC. The area provides work stations for 400 journalists. Plasma screens display the live host broadcast feed from the competition venues. The media work area is subdivided into clusters showing the different sports on specific televisions allowing media to select a work station in the appropriate area to cover the relevant sport.

## **Photo Work Area**

The photo work area is adjacent to the media work area and is conveniently situated to all services and facilities. The area provides work stations for 200 photographers. Plasma screens display the live host broadcast feed from the competition venues. The photo work area is subdivided into clusters showing the different sports on specific televisions allowing photographers to select a work station in the appropriate area to cover the relevant sport.

## **Private Office Space**

Private Office Space is situated in the MPC. Media organisations can rent Private Office Space. It is the responsibility of the relevant media organisation to ensure its Private Office Space is secure when not in use.

## **Press Conference Rooms**

The daily media conference schedule will be available from the Welcome Desk, the Help Desk and on GamesINFO. Press conferences will be shown on selected televisions in the MPC with audio available. The Press Conference Room is located in the MPC, Hall No 12, and will host the “daily media briefing”. The room is equipped with splitter boxes and seats 200 journalists. All press conferences or briefings held in the MPC conference room will be announced.

## **SERVICES**

### **Rate Card Telecommunications**

Media who have ordered a Rate Card service should contact the Rate Card Services team operating from the Rate Card Desk, who will advise where the telecommunication service is installed and the operation of this service.

### **Desktop Payphones**

Located within the media and photo work areas, desktop payphones have a data port for connection to equipment, ie modem. To operate the desktop payphones, pre-paid phone cards are available from vending machines conveniently located throughout the MPC.

### **GamesINFO Terminals**

Located adjacent to the media and photo work areas, media can access results, biographies, news items and other Delhi 2010 Commonwealth Games related information.

### **Internet Terminals**

Located adjacent to the media and photo work areas, media can access the internet and use web-based email. This is a free of charge service.

### **Photocopy Service**

A free photocopy service is available in the Business Centre operated by the Media Services team.

### **Lockers**

Lockers for media use are located adjacent to the media and photo work areas. Keys are available from the Help Desk on payment of a cash deposit. The locker key deposit is refundable on return of the key to the Help Desk.

### **Storage**

Any personal items or items of equipment left unattended, including in the lockers, is done entirely at the risk of the owner.

### **Media Lounge**

The Media Lounge is located at the south end of the MPC. This is a dedicated area for media and is equipped with television monitors. When the MPC operates 24 hours, tea/coffee/cookies is available.

## **Venue Media Centres**

### **Thyagaraja Stadium - Netball**

#### **Venue Information**

The venue is owned by the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (GNCTD). Thyagaraja is located in south Delhi, south west of Connaught Place and approximately 30 minutes driving time from the Main Press Centre. It is the competition venue for netball competitions. The total seating capacity of the stadium is 4,800.

#### **General Information:**

#### **Opening Hours**

The Venue Media Centre opens on Monday, October 4, 2010, the day when competition begins, and closes on Thursday, October 14, 2010, the day of the Closing Ceremony. On competition days, it will open approximately two hours prior to competition and close approximately two hours after competition has finished. The Venue Media Centre will remain closed on non-competition days.

#### **Access to the Venue**

The media load zone and the drop off point is located in the south-east direction of the venue. A media T4 transport service will operate from the Main Press Centre Transport Mall to the venue.

#### **Public Transport**

The venue is connected via INA Metro Station. It is five-minute walking distance from Safdarjung Bus Terminal.

#### **Media Entry**

Media entry to the venue is 50 metres to the west of the media load zone.

## **VENUE MEDIA CENTRE**

#### **Media Work Area Facilities**

The Venue Media Centre is located on second level, on the south-east side of the venue. It includes facilities such as work stations, Internet facilities, information desk, results information, photocopying/facsimile service and Games INFO terminals. The office of the Venue Media Manager is also located here.

#### **Tribune Seating**

The Press Tribune is located centrally on the south side of the show court. The Press Tribune is accessible via the first level of the seating stand.

#### **Mixed Zone**

The Mixed Zone is located in the south-east corner of the field of play.

### **Press Conference Room**

The Media Conference Room is located at the ground level in the south-east corner of the stadium. Press conferences are not scheduled at this venue, but will be held if required.

### **Media Catering**

Catering concession outlets are available in the spectator area. These facilities are all user-pay. Complimentary tea and coffee will be available in the Media Lounge at the concourse of first level.

### **PHOTO SERVICES**

#### **Photo Positions**

Photo positions are located in the first row of the seating stand, of the Press Tribunes, on the south side of the show court. Photo positions are located in the north-east and south-west corners of the court.

Photo positions may be accessed 45 minutes prior to the start of competition.

## **Talkatora Stadium - Boxing**

### **Venue Information**

The Talkatora Stadium is owned by the New Delhi Municipal Corporation (NDMC). The venue is centrally located in Delhi, approximately 20 minutes driving distance from the Main Press Centre. It is the competition venue for boxing competitions. The total seating capacity of the stadium is 3,035.

### **General Information:**

#### **Opening Hours**

The Venue Media Centre opens on Monday, October 5, 2010, the day when competition begins, and closes on Thursday, October 13, 2010. On competition days, it will open approximately two hours prior to competition and close approximately two hours after competition has finished. The Venue Media Centre will remain closed on non-competition days.

#### **Access to the Venue**

The media load zone and the drop off point is on the service lane on the left of Mandir Marg- Shankar Road roundabout, north of the venue. A media T4 transport service will operate from the Main Press Centre Transport Mall to the venue.

#### **Public Transport**

It is ten-minute walking distance from the Mandir Marg Bus Terminal.

#### **Media Entry**

Media entry to the venue is 200 metres to the south of the media load zone.

## **VENUE MEDIA CENTRE**

#### **Media Work Area Facilities**

The Venue Media Centre is located on the second level, on the south side of the facility centre. It includes facilities such as the information desk, results information, photocopying/facsimile service, desktop and Games INFO terminals. The Venue Media Manager is also located here.

#### **Tribune Seating**

The Press Tribune is located on the south side of the show court. The Press Tribune is accessible via the front of the seating stand.

#### **Mixed Zone**

The Mixed Zone is located on the ground level, near the field of play.

#### **Press Conference Room**

The Press Conference Room is located at the second level of the facility centre, adjoining to the stadium.

#### **Media Catering**

A number of catering outlets are available within a short walk of the Venue Media Centre. These facilities are all user-pay. Complimentary tea and coffee will be available in the Media Lounge.

### Photo Positions

Photo positions are located in the first row of the seating stand, of the Press Tribunes, on the south side of the show court. Also photo positions are located in the corners of the court. Photo positions may be accessed 45 minutes prior to the start of competition.

## **S.P. Mukherjee Stadium - Aquatics**

### **Venue Information**

The S.P. Mukherjee Stadium is owned by the Sports Authority of India (SAI). The venue is centrally located in Delhi, approximately 20 minutes driving distance from the Main Press Centre. It will be the competition venue for aquatics events. The total seating capacity is 5,178.

### **General Information:**

#### **Opening Hours**

The Venue Media Centre opens on Monday, October 4, 2010, the day when competition begins, and closes on Thursday, October 13, 2010.

On competition days, it will open approximately two hours prior to competition and close approximately two hours after competition has finished. The Venue Media Centre will remain close on the non-competition days.

#### **Access to the Venue**

The media load zone and the drop off point is on the service lane on the south of the stadium at the Mother Teresa Road. Media T4 transport service will operate from the Main Press Centre Transport Mall to the venue.

#### **Media Entry**

Media entry to the venue is 150 metres to the south of the media load zone.

## **VENUE MEDIA CENTRE**

### **Media Work Area Facilities**

The Venue Media Centre is located on the first level, on the west side of the stadium centre. It includes facilities such as the workstations with desktops, Internet, information desk, results information, photocopying/facsimile service, desktop and Games INFO terminals. The Venue Media Manager's office is also located at the same level.

### **Tribune Seating**

The Press Tribune is located at the second level, vertically connected with the workroom.

### **Mixed Zone**

The Mixed Zone is located on the ground level, near the field of play. The Mixed Zone can be accessed via vertical circulation from the tribunes and the workroom.

### **Press Conference Room**

The Press Conference Room is located at the ground level of the stadium, near the media entry point.

### **Media Catering**

Catering concession outlets are available in the spectator plaza on user-pay basis. Complimentary tea and coffee will be available in the Media Lounge which is at the first level adjoining to the work areas.

Photo positions are located in the first row of the spectator seating stand, on the south side of the pool and also near the centre of the pool. Photo positions may be accessed 45 minutes prior to the start of competition.

## **Indira Gandhi Stadium**

### **a. Gymnastics**

#### **Venue Information**

The Gymnastics stadium is owned by Sports Authority of India (SAI). The venue is close to the Games Village and the Main Press Centre, approximately 20-minute driving distance from the Main Press Centre. It will be the competition venue for gymnastics events. The total seating capacity is 14,348.

#### **General Information:**

##### **Opening Hours**

The Venue Media Centre opens on Monday, October 4, 2010, the day when competition starts, and closes on Thursday, October 14, 2010. On competition days, it will open approximately two hours prior to competition and close approximately two hours after competition has finished. The Venue Media Centre will remain close on the non-competition days i.e. October 9 to 12, 2010.

##### **Access to the Venue**

The media load zone and the drop off point is on the service lane on the west of the stadium. Media T4 transport service will operate from the Main Press Centre Transport Mall to the venue.

##### **Public Transport**

The venue is adjoining to the Ring Road and can be accessed by city buses.

##### **Media Entry**

Media entry to the venue is 80 metres to the east of the media drop off point.

## **VENUE MEDIA CENTRE**

##### **Media Work Area Facilities**

The Venue Media Centre is located on the ground level. It includes facilities such as the workstations with desktops, Internet, information desk, results information, photocopying/facsimile service, desktop and Games INFO terminals. The Venue Media Manager's office is also located in the same area.

##### **Tribune Seating**

The Press Tribune is located at the first & second level, vertically connected with the workrooms.

##### **Mixed Zone**

The Mixed Zone is located on the ground level, near the field of play. The Mixed Zone can be accessed via vertical circulation from the tribunes and the workroom.

### **Press Conference Room**

The Press Conference Room is located at the ground level of the stadium, opposite the media workroom.

### **Media Catering**

Catering concession outlets are available in the spectator plaza on user-pay basis. Complimentary tea and coffee will be available in the Media Lounge which is at the first level.

## **b. Wrestling**

### **Venue Information**

The wrestling stadium is in the Indira Gandhi Sports Complex owned by the Sports Authority of India (SAI). The venue is approximately 15 minutes driving distance from the Main Press Centre. It is the competition venue for wrestling. The total seating capacity is 6,932.

### **General Information:**

#### **Opening Hours**

The Venue Media Centre opens on Tuesday, October 5, 2010, the day when competition starts, and closes on Sunday, October 10, 2010. On competition days, it will open approximately two hours prior to competition and close approximately two hours after competition has finished. The Venue Media Centre will remain close on non-competition days.

#### **Access to the Venue**

The media load zone and the drop off point is on the service lane on the north of the stadium at the Velodrome Road. Media T4 transport service will operate from the Main Press Centre Transport Mall to the venue.

#### **Public Transport**

The venue is adjoining to the Ring Road and can be accessed by city buses.

#### **Media Entry**

Media entry to the venue is 70 metres to the south of the media load zone.

## VENUE MEDIA CENTRE

### Media Work Area Facilities

The Venue Media Centre is located on the ground level, on the west side of the stadium centre. It includes facilities such as the workstations with desktops, internet, information desk, results information, photocopying/facsimile service, desktop and Games INFO terminals. The Venue Media Manager's office is also located at the first level.

The Press Tribune is located at the second level.

## c. Cycling

The cycling velodrome is located within the Indira Gandhi Sports Complex owned by the Sports Authority of India (SAI). The venue is 15 minutes drive from the Main Press Centre. It is the competition venue for cycling. The total seating capacity is 4,000.

The Venue Media Centre opens on Monday, October 4, 2010, the day when competition starts, and closes on Thursday, October 7, 2010. On competition days, it will open approximately two hours prior to competition and close approximately two hours after competition has finished. The Venue Media Centre will remain close on the non-competition days.

### Access to the Venue

The media load zone and the drop off point is on the service lane on the north of the stadium at the Velodrome Road. Media T4 transport service will operate from the Main Press Centre Transport Mall to the venue.

### Public Transport

The venue is adjoining to the Ring Road and can be accessed by buses.

### Media Entry

Media entry to the venue is 150 metres to the south of the media load zone.

## VENUE MEDIA CENTRE

### Media Work Area Facilities

Venue Media Centre is located on the first level. It includes facilities such as the workstations with desktops, internet, information desk, results information, photocopying/facsimile service, desktop and Games INFO terminals. The Venue Media Manager's office is also located at the same level.

## **Major Dhyan Chand National Stadium - Hockey**

### **Venue Information**

Major Dhyan Chand National Stadium is owned by Sports Authority of India (SAI). The venue is just five minutes drive from the Main Press Centre. It is the competition venue for hockey. The stadium boasts of two pitches. The seating capacity of pitch 1 is 19,118 while that of pitch 2 is 2,500.

### **General Information**

#### **Opening Hours**

The Venue Media Centre opens on Monday, October 4, 2010, the day when competition starts, and closes on Thursday, October 14, 2010. On competition days, it will open approximately two hours prior to competition and close approximately two hours after competition has finished.

#### **Access to the Venue**

The media load zone and the drop off point is on the service lane on the gate no 2 of the stadium. Media T4 transport service will operate from the Main Press Centre Transport Mall to the venue.

#### **Public Transport**

The venue is next to the landmark monument India Gate. One can have access to the stadium via cab service.

#### **Media Entry**

Media entry to the venue is 50 metres for Pitch1 and around 100m for Pitch2 from the media drop off point.

## **VENUE MEDIA CENTRE**

The National stadium has a fully equipped Venue Media Centre (VMC) for the Press managed by Press Operations. It incorporates the Press Work Area, Photographers' Work Area, Media Lounge, Games News Service office and the office of the Venue Media Manager. The VMC provides facilities and services that will facilitate accredited journalists and photographers to perform with ease; most vitally, it will ensure quick and efficient service so that they can file their stories and photos of the day's action and meet global deadlines. The workroom at pitch No. 1 is at the basement level with a capacity for 65 whereas pitch No. 2 workroom can accommodate 25 people.

#### **Tribune Seating**

The Press Tribune is located at the second level, vertically connected with the workrooms.

#### **Mixed Zone**

The Mixed Zone is located near the field of play. The mixed zone can be accessed via vertical circulation from the tribunes and the workrooms.

### **Press Conference Room**

The Press Conference Room is located at the basement level of the stadium, opposite the media workroom.

### **Media Catering**

Catering concession outlets are available in the spectator plaza on user-pay basis. Complimentary tea and coffee is available in the Media Lounge which is at the first level.

## **Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium**

### **Venue Information**

The Sports Authority of India (SAI) owns the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium. The venue is 15 minutes driving distance from the Main Press Centre and around 30 minutes drive from the Games Village. It is the competition venue for athletics, lawn balls and weightlifting. The main athletics stadium will host the Opening and the Closing ceremonies of Delhi 2010. The total capacity of the stadium is 60,000.

### **a. Athletics**

#### **General Information**

##### **Opening Hours**

The Venue Media Centre opens on Sunday, October 3, 2010, the day of the Opening Ceremony, and closes on Thursday, October 14, 2010. On competition days i.e. 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> October, it will open approximately two hours prior to competition and close approximately two hours after the last event has finished.

##### **Access to the Venue**

The media load zone and the drop off points are on the on the west of the stadium. Media T4 transport service will operate from the Main Press Centre Transport Mall to the venue.

##### **Media Entry**

Media entry to the venue is 100 metres away from the media drop off point.

#### **VENUE MEDIA CENTRE**

The Nehru stadium boasts of a fully equipped Venue Media Centre (VMC) for the press. It incorporates the Press Work Area, Photographers' Work Area, Media Lounge, Games News Service office and the office of the Venue Media Manager and is one of the biggest media centres being set up for the Delhi 2010 Games.

##### **Tribune Seating**

The Press Tribune is located at the first level, as the workrooms.

##### **Mixed Zone**

The Mixed Zone is located at the south west direction of the field of play. The mixed zone can be accessed via vertical circulation from the tribunes and the workrooms.

##### **Press Conference Room**

The Press Conference Room is located at the ground level of the stadium near the media entry point in South West direction.

##### **Media Catering**

Catering concession outlets are available in the spectator plaza on user-pay basis.

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Complimentary tea and coffee will be available in the Media Lounge which is at the first level.

## B. Lawn Balls

#### Access to the Venue

The media load zone and the drop off points are on the on the south east of the stadium. Media T4 transport service will operate from the Main Press Centre Transport Mall to the venue.

#### Media Entry

Media entry to the venue is 120 metres away in the south east direction from the media drop off point.

## VENUE MEDIA CENTRE

### Media Work Area Facilities

The Venue Media Centre is located on the ground level, on the south side of the facility centre. It includes facilities such as the information desk, results information, photocopying/facsimile service, desktop and Games INFO terminals. The Venue Media Manager is also located here.

### Tribune Seating

The tribunes are located at the ground level. Only Green 1 and green 2 have tabled tribunes. Green 3 and 4 are provided with non tabled tribunes.

### Mixed Zone

The Mixed Zone is located at the south east direction of the field of play. The mixed zone can be accessed via vertical circulation from the tribunes.

### Press Conference Room

## **Games News Service**

### **Introduction To The Games News Service**

The Games News Service is an internal news agency that collects, creates and publishes a range of Games-related news and data on **Games INFO**.

Games Info is an essential resource providing timely, factual and accurate material for accredited media, broadcasters, sponsors, athletes, national delegation and the broader Games-family, which relies on the Games News Service for comprehensive coverage of the events and sporting competitions and many other aspects of the Commonwealth Games. The Games News Service team consists of sports writers, experts, researchers, editors, media volunteers and associated personnel.

### **What The Games News Service Will Provide**

The articles prepared and published by the Games News Service include daily previews and reviews, competition previews and reviews, flash quotes from athletes and coaches, press conference highlights, stories about specific athletes and other media communications. The Games News Service will also provide a range of additional background Information, such as athletes' biographies, medal tallies, statistics, historical information and general Games news such as weather, transport, attendances etc. Any error in information produced by the Games News Service which requires updating or amendment will be corrected as soon as possible and the revised versions marked 'CORRECTED'.

### **Games News Service Operation**

Games News Service will generate most of the content 'on location' at competition venues, to channel it back through a central editorial team located at the Main Press Centre. A Games News Service team will be based at every competition venue managed by a Games News Service Team Leader and Sports Information Specialist; the team will also consist of News Service Reporter and Flash Quote Reporters.

### **How To Access Information Published by the Games News Service**

Games News Service articles and information will be distributed in hard copy via the pigeon holes located in the Main Press Centre and Venue Media Centres. Printed results will be distributed to the tabled tribunes. All Games News Service articles and information are accessible electronically via GamesInfo. This system functions on dedicated computer terminals stationed at the Main Press Centre and Venue Media Centres. GamesInfo will display news, sport competition schedules, results and records, athlete biographies, medal tally, sport information; media transport schedules, weather information, as well as an extensive schedule of Village and cultural events, tourism and historical Games information. All Games News Service information will be published in English.

**2. TRANSPORT**

Accredited media personnel will be entitled for T4 transport. The mode of transportation will be air-conditioned shuttle bus with a capacity of 35 people. The bus will travel between the Media hotels and the Main Press Centre; and from the Main Press Centre to various competition venues. There will be a minimum of 80 T4 buses available for the media.



### **3. ACCREDITATION**

D2010 will ensure a smooth and hassle-free accreditation process for the media. It is the aim of D2010 Games Organising Committee to encourage maximum coverage of the Games. All the CGAs are being requested to send their requirements for media accreditations to the Organising Committee Commonwealth Games Delhi 2010 by January 1, 2010.

The online accreditation process for media (print journalists, photographers and non-rights holding broadcasters) will commence from April 1, 2010 to June 15, 2010. All the accreditation applications for international media will be issued a Non Valid Pass (NVP) which will be validated on arrival at the Indira Gandhi International Airport. Members of the international media will also have the option of validating their NVP at the Media Accreditation Centre.

Delhi 2010 will follow the same process for media accreditation as was done in the previous Games. All media entries need to be submitted by the respective CGA. Each CGA will be given a login name and password to facilitate this process.

While media accreditation forms will be accepted after the last due date, i.e. June 15, 2010, no NVPs will be issued thereafter and applicants would need to apply for an Indian visa through the respective Indian High Commission in their region. They would also need to collect their accreditation cards from the Media Accreditation Centre at Pragati Maidan (close to the Main Press Centre). The last date for submitting all forms is September 3, 2010.

The Delhi 2010 Queen's Baton Relay is taking this much-loved Games tradition on a unique history-making journey, travelling more than 180,000km, visiting all 70 Nations and Territories of the Commonwealth. The Delhi 2010 Queen's Baton commences its epic journey to the Games on October 29, when Her Majesty hands the Delhi 2010 Queen's Baton to the first of many thousands of relay runners that will carry it to the Games. The baton will journey 170,000km for 236 days in the international sector, comprising all nations of the Commonwealth. On its 100-day national tour, the baton will visit every Indian state and its capital, plus many other cities along the way, covering in excess of 20,000km. The Baton arrives in India through Wagah Border (crossing between India and Pakistan) on June 25, 2010. It will then commence a 100 Days National tour visiting 28 States and 7 Union Territories of India

The Commonwealth is a unique family of developed and developing nations spread over every continent and ocean. From Africa to Asia, from Pacific shores to the Caribbean, the Commonwealth's 1.8 billion people make up one-third of the world's population and are of many faiths, races, languages and cultures. India officially became a member of the Commonwealth of Nations in 1931. The 70 Nations and Territories of the Commonwealth are grouped into six regions.

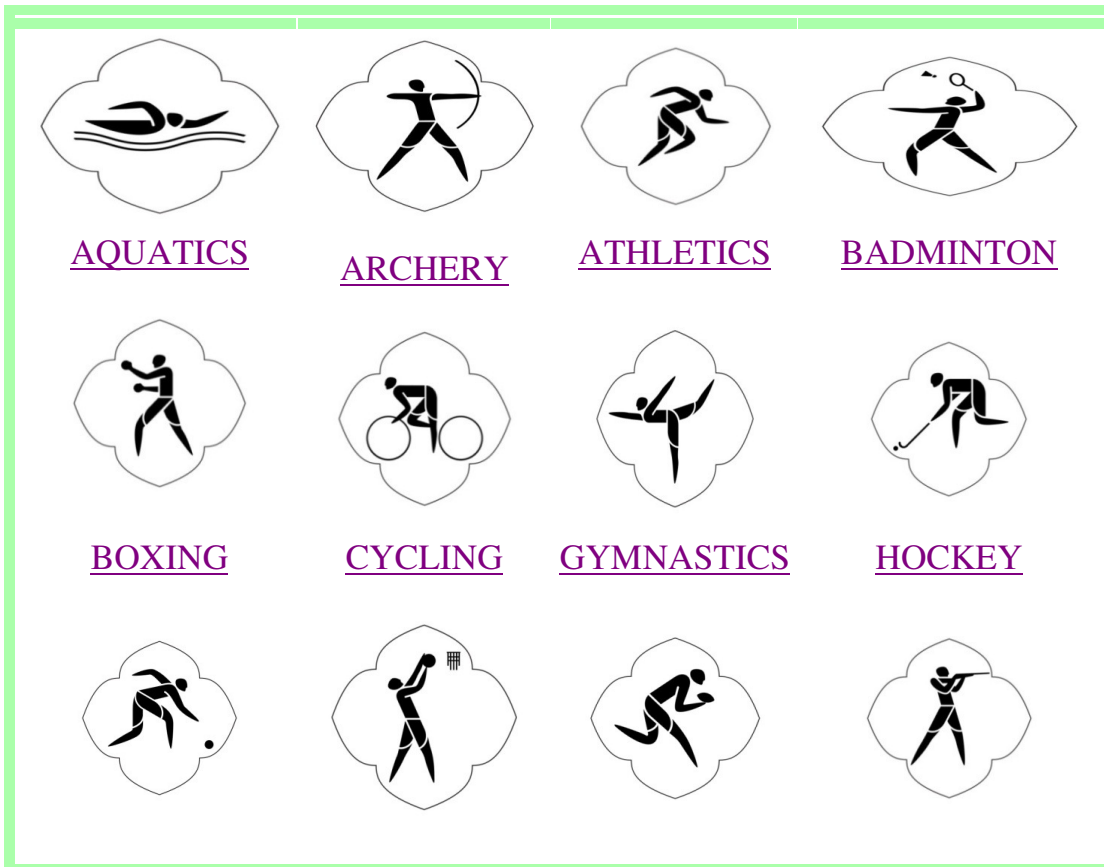
