



About NOA

The National Olympic Academy (NOA) is the academic arm of the Olympic Council of Malaysia (OCM) and is responsible for promoting Olympic Philosophy and Olympic Education. The NOA does this by organising programmes, activities, courses and competitions with sport as the vehicle.

About the Art Competition

This will be an On the Spot-Art-Competition, and the first to be organized by NOA Malaysia to commemorate NOA's 10th Anniversary. We invite children from 7 to 12 years old to come and join us in this art competition. The competition will be held in the OCM Indoor Sports Arena, Level 3, on 7th April 2007, and registration will start at 8.00am. Only the first 100 applications will be accepted.

Objective

1. To promote olympic values and ethics by blending sport and art.
2. To bring together children of various races, religions and backgrounds to participate in friendly competitions and derive joy from effort.
3. To use art to focus on the universal values of unity, tolerance, understanding and fair play which can be developed through sports.

Prizes

1. The entries will be judged by the organizers with the help of a jury. The judges' decision will be final.
2. Three (3) most outstanding entries will each receive a prize and a certificate of merit.
3. Seven (7) consolation prizes will also be given.

Exhibition

All winning entries of the OLYMPIC ART COMPETITION will be exhibited in the OCM Sports Museum & Hall of Fame for a stipulated time to be decided by the Olympic Council of Malaysia.

Competition Rules

1. The competition is open to all young people, between 7 - 12 years of age.
 2. The competition will be held in two (2) categories:
Category 1: Boys and girls born in the years 1998, 1999 and 2000
Category 2: Boys and girls born in the years 1995, 1996 and 1997
 3. Participation is FREE and no fee is charged.
 4. Participants should cover the theme as described for their artwork. The participant's artwork should portray the theme, "Unity Through Sports".
 5. Artwork entries can be produced in any medium listed below:
 - 5.1 Crayons
 - 5.2 Pastels
 - 5.3 Felt tip markers
 - 5.4 Watercolour paints
 - 5.5 Colouring pencils
 6. Artwork entries should be A3 size: (420 x 297 mm or 16.54 x 11.69 inches)
 7. Drawing paper will be provided by the organizer.
 8. Participants are entitled to one single entry.
 9. The entry should reflect the sole effort of the participant, and NOT be the result of combined efforts.
 10. No entry will be returned. The copyright of all entries will rest with the Olympic Council Malaysia.
